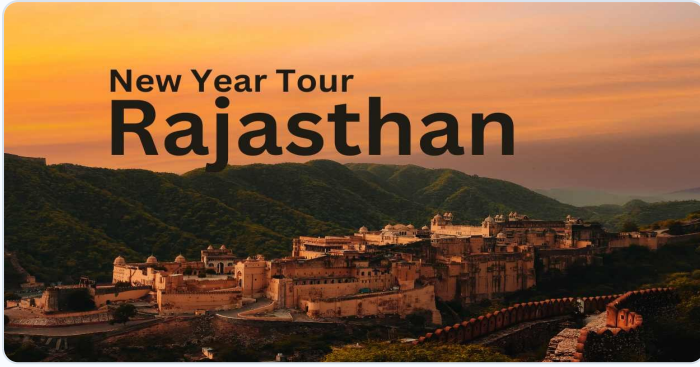

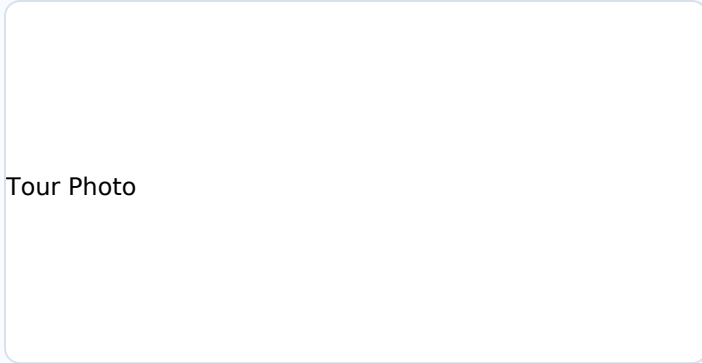
## Best Time for Rajasthan New Year Tour
