Detailed Itinerary for 8 Nights and 9 Days:

Day 1: Arrival in Jaipur + Sightseeing in Jaipur

The Rajasthan tour package from Mumbai starts when you reach Jaipur from Mumbai. Our tour representative will pick you up from Jaipur Railway Station/ Jaipur International Airport. We will then transfer you by private cab to the pre-booked hotel in Jaipur. After you check into the hotel we will visit Birla Temple. This temple is famous for its marble architecture and is dedicated to Goddess Lakshmi and Lord Vishnu. You can view the marble statues of Hindu deities along with those of Socrates, Jesus, Buddha, Confucius, and other gods.

After this visit to Birla Temple, you will visit Nahargarh Fort. The fort is one of the biggest forts in Jaipur. The fort offers panoramic views of Jaipur along with Man Sagar Lake. Nahargarh Fort has an ancient stepwell also. Proceed ahead in this tour and you will visit Chokhi Dhani. You can enjoy various Rajasthani cultural activities at Chokhi Dhani. This is a resort with Rajasthani-styled interiors and décor.

The Rajasthani meal at the restaurant at Chokhi Dhani is prepared with authentic spices and cooking methods. You will love its taste and aroma. After this day's sightseeing is over, we will drop you to the hotel in Jaipur. You can relax and stay here for the night.

Day 2: Jaipur Sightseeing Tour

On this second day of Rajasthan packages from Mumbai today, we will visit Jaipur and its various places. After breakfast, we will leave the hotel and visit Amer Fort. The locals also call this fort as Amber Palace. The fort is a world-famous heritage site and one of the major tourist attractions in Jaipur. You will visit the various palaces and courtyards inside the fort. The fort is huge and will take at least 2 hours to visit. You must watch out for the elegant painted walls and gates. The Mughal gardens inside the fort are also a special attraction.

After this visit, we will visit Hawa Mahal. This is the palace with numerous small windows, and it is said that cool winds blow through these windows and cool the interiors. The front part of the palace is iconic and famous all over the world.

Later we will visit Jaipur City Palace. This is a huge palace complex with numerous palaces and gates. The enormous courtyards inside the palace are fabulous. Mubarak Mahal, Chandra Mahal, Govind Deoji Temple, Pritam Niwas Chowk, and Sabha Niwas are the various places to visit inside the palace complex. The museum in Sabha Niwas has a rich collection of ancient and medieval objects like rugs, trophies, weapons, costumes, etc.

After this visit, you will visit Johari Bazaar. This is a market for jewelry and ornaments. You can even find enough time to shop in this market. After this amazing day of sightseeing in Jaipur, we will drop you to your hotel in Jaipur. You can have a relishing dinner and stay here for the night.

Day 3: Jaipur to Bikaner + Karni Mata Temple visit

Today is the third day of Rajasthan packages from Mumbai. Today you will check-out from the hotel in Jaipur and proceed to another famous destination of Rajasthan, which is Bikaner. You will drive to Bikaner by a private cab and on the journey you can

enjoy the views of the desert. When you reach Bikaner you will check into the hotel and rest here for a while after a long journey.

Later we will visit Karni Mata Temple. This temple is famous for its rats. These rats are considered to be devoted followers of Karni Mata. After this visit, you will have dinner which consists of Rajasthani dishes. After dinner, you may have a rest in the hotel and overnight stay.

Day 4: Bikaner to Jaisalmer + Sightseeing in Jaisalmer

On this fourth day of the Rajasthan trip from Mumbai, you will check-out from the hotel in Bikaner. We will now proceed to yet another famous destination in Rajasthan, which is Jaisalmer. This will be a journey of 5 hours and you can enjoy the desert views from your car. When you arrive in the city of Jaisalmer, you will check into the hotel that was pre-booked for this particular tour. After some moments of relaxation, we will visit the famous tourist landmarks in Jaisalmer.

We will start this Jaisalmer sightseeing with a visit to Jaisalmer Fort. This fort is also known as Sonar Quila. The famous thing about this fort is that many people have been living inside the fort since ancient times. They have built havelis inside the fort, and these are now turned into havelis for tourists. You can visit the Jain temple inside the fort. There are an astonishing 7 Jain temples inside the fort and all of them are famous for their architecture.

After this fort visit, we will proceed further in this tour and visit the famous havelis in Jaisalmer. These are Patwon ki Haveli, Salim Singh ki Haveli, and Nathmal ki Haveli. All these Havelis are famous for their sandstone architecture and vintage construction. These havelis were built by the wealthy merchants of Jaisalmer and are great tourist attractions.

In the evening we will visit Gadisar Lake. The lake has wonderful views of shrines, temples, and monuments all around it. You can feed the catfish that swim in the waters of the lake. You can sit beside the lake and enjoy the golden sunset views. Later we will return to our hotel and have dinner. You will now go to rest and stay in the hotel for the night.

Day 5: Jaisalmer sightseeing + Sam sand dunes desert safari

This is your fifth day of this Rajasthan tours from Mumbai. You will wake up early and view the golden sunrise views. After breakfast, you will go on a sightseeing tour of Jaisalmer. We will visit Bada Bagh. This is a garden complex with fantastic monuments and memorials. Bada Bagh has many chhatris, which are monuments with umbrella-shaped domes. These monuments were made in the memory of former kings of Jaisalmer. The memorials have wonderful architecture and elegant construction made of yellow sandstone.

After lunch, you will visit the Sam sand dunes area of Jaisalmer. This is 40 km from Jaisalmer and you can reach it by jeep. Here you will check into the desert camp and go for camel rides. The jeep rides here will thrill you beyond words. You will race up and down the sand dunes and it will be an exciting adventure. You can take many photographs of the sand dunes and desert landscape.

You can relax in the tent and enjoy the warm hospitality of the hosts. In the evening you can enjoy the Rajasthani cultural activities which include folk dance and music performances. You will have dinner of Rajasthani dishes under the open sky and beside the bonfire. You can enjoy the starry night sky and count the stars if you wish. You will now rest and stay in the desert camp and spend the night here.

Day 6: Jaisalmer to Jodhpur

As per our Rajasthan tour itinerary from Mumbai, we will check-out from the desert camp in Jaisalmer. Our next destination of this Rajasthan family tour packages from Mumbai is the Blue City of India, which is Jodhpur. You will check into the hotel in Jodhpur on arrival.

After some rest, we will go and visit Mehrangarh Fort. This fort has many palaces and fortified gates. The museum inside Mehrangarh Fort has palanquins, royal costumes, armor, weapons, vintage clocks, and other royal objects. You can view the city of Jodhpur from atop the fort.

Jaswant Thada is the next tourist attraction we will visit. The monument is famous for its marble architecture and paintings of royal kings. After lunch, we will visit Umaid Bhawan Palace. This palace is considered to be among the largest private residences in the world. The royal family of Jodhpur still lives in one section of the palace. There is a museum inside the palace which has a huge collection of royal antiquities. Today one part of the palace is converted into a 5-star luxury hotel.

Later you can explore the local market in Jodhpur. These markets have existed for many years and still are local favorites for household products. You can buy some Rajasthani items from these markets such as jootis, Rajasthani jewelry, handbags, etc. After this visit, you will return to your hotel and have dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 7: Jodhpur to Udaipur + Sightseeing in Udaipur

Today we arrived on Day 7 of this Rajasthan holiday packages from Mumbai. You will check-out from Jodhpur and proceed to another famous destination of this Rajasthan group tour packages from Mumbai. We will reach Udaipur by car and you can check into the hotel. After some rest, you will go and visit the Eklingji Temple and Nagda Temple. These temples are well-known for their temple architecture. These temples are centuries old and are still intact and in good condition. In the evening you will return to the hotel and have dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 8: Sightseeing in Udaipur
