Day 1 - Jaipur Railway station/Airport

Day 2 - Jaipur Local Sightseeing

After breakfast, your Jaipur Local Sightseeing journey will get started that will cover the following: During your trip to Jaipur, there are several must-see places that you should definitely visit.

Amber fort:- The Amber Fort is a beautiful palace that was once the residence of the Rajput Maharajas and their families. When you arrive at the fort's Ganesh Gate, you'll see a temple dedicated to Shila Devi, a Goddess of the Chaitanya cult, which was given to Raja Man Singh after he defeated the Raja of Jessore, Bengal in 1604.

Maatha Lake:- Another must-see is the Maatha Lake, located in Amber. This lake was originally named "Mahavata," but it's now commonly known as Maota because of the large trees that are located near it.

Nahargarh fort:- You should also visit the Nahargarh Fort, which stands on the edge of the Aravalli Hills and overlooks the city of Jaipur. Along with Amer Fort and Jaigarh Fort, Nahargarh once formed a strong defence ring

Day 3

Day 3 - Jaipur Local Sightseeing

Begin your Jaipur Local Sightseeing after breakfast and visit the following places:

City Palace:- Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II established the City Palace, Jaipur at the same time he founded the city of Jaipur in 1727. He had moved his court to Jaipur from Amber.

Jantar Mantar :- The Jantar Mantar in Jaipur was built in the early 1800s and serves as an astronomical observation site. The site comprises around 20 main fixed instruments, which are constructed using masonry and are remarkable examples of known instruments with some unique features of their own.

Hawa Mahal :- In 1799, Maharaja Sawai Pratap Singh, the grandson of Jaipur's founder Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh, built a grand and historic palace called Hawa Mahal. The unique structure of Khetri Mahal inspired him, and Lal Chand Ustad designed the palace.

Albert Hall Museum:- The Albert Hall Museum is the oldest museum in the state of Rajasthan, India. It is located in

Day 4 - Transfer to Jodhpur via Ajmer & Pushkar

After having breakfast, check out from your hotel and head towards Jodhpur. On the way, take a stop to visit Ajmer and Pushkar. Begin your Ajmer local sightseeing by visiting Ajmer-e-Sharif Dargah.

According to legend, Khawaja Moinuddin Chisti came to India from Persia to serve the poor and the needy. The Dargah is his final resting place and is said to have been constructed by the Mughal Emperor Humayun.

Adhai-Din-ka Jhonpara :- The Adhai Din Ka Jhonpra, also known as Arhai Din ka Jhompra or Dhai Din ki Masjid, is a mosque located in Ajmer, Rajasthan. The name Adhai Din Ka Jhonpra is believed to have originated from a legend that states that a part of the mosque was built in just two and a half days.

However, some Sufis claim that the name signifies the temporary nature of human life on earth. According to the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI), the name probably comes from a two-and-a-half-day-long fair that used to be held at the site

Day 5

Day 5 - Transfer to Jaisalmer City & Jodhpur Local Sightseeing

After having breakfast and checking out from the hotel, you will be transferred to Jaisalmer City, where you can begin your sightseeing tour of Jodhpur.

Mehrangarh fort:- Named after the mythical descent of the clan from the sun god Surya, the fort was called Mehrangarh, meaning "fort of the sun." It spans over 500 yards in length, with walls rising to a height of 120 feet and a thickness of 70 feet in some areas. While essential for the successors of Rao Jodha, the fort's defences were not always sufficient.

Jaswant Thada:- The Jaswant Thada, situated in Jodhpur, Rajasthan, India, is a memorial cenotaph built by Maharaja Sardar Singh of Jodhpur State in 1899. It was constructed to honour the memory of his father, Maharaja Jaswant Singh II, and also serves as a burial ground for the royal Rajput family of Marwar.

Umaid Bhawan:- One of the largest private residences in the world is the Umaid Bhawan Palace, situated in Jodhpur, Rajasthan, India.

Day 6

Day 6 - Transfer to Jaisalmer Desert & Jaisalmer City Local Sightseeing

After having breakfast, check out from your hotel and proceed to Jaisalmer Desert. Begin your Jaisalmer City Local Sightseeing.

Patwan Ki Haveli:- The Patwa Haveli, belonging to the Kothari family, has a history that dates back to the early eighteenth century. At that time, the Patwa brothers were facing struggles in setting up their trade and business in Jaisalmer. Upon the advice of a priest at the Jain Temple, they left the city with no intention of returning, as they were advised that their business would not flourish there. It is said that after leaving Jaisalmer, their business prospered immensely and spanned various fields, such as banking and finance, silver, brocade, and the opium trade.

They even rose to such heights that they were called upon to finance the state deficit. However, their fortunes took a downturn after they returned to Jaisalmer, and they had to abandon the city once again, leaving the havelis under the care of others. In due course of

Day 7**Day 7 - Transfer to Udaipur Via War Museum, Mini Dubai**

After breakfast, you will check out from your hotel and be transferred to Udaipur. On the way, you will have the opportunity to visit the War Museum and Mini Dubai.

War Museum:- IWM, or the Imperial War Museum, was established on March 5th, 1917 following the War Cabinet's approval of a proposal put forth by Sir Alfred Mond MP. The proposal suggested the establishment of a national war museum that would document the ongoing events of the Great War.

Mini Dubai (Dates Farmhouse):- BluSalz Rural The Date Farm in Jaisalmer is situated in Sodākor and provides guests with a garden, a shared lounge, and a restaurant. The farm stay includes a bathroom. After your stay at the farm, continue your drive to Udaipur, check in to your hotel, and spend the night there.

Day 8**Day 8 - Udaipur Local Sightseeing & Drop at Udaipur Airport / Railway station**

After breakfast, check out from the hotel. Start your Udaipur Local Sightseeing. We will cover:

City Palace:- The construction of the Udaipur City Palace began in 1553 and was completed over the course of nearly 400 years, with contributions from several rulers of the Mewar dynasty. Maharana Udai Singh II of the Sisodia Rajput family started the construction as he shifted his capital from the former Chittor to the newly founded city of Udaipur.

Pichala Lake:- Lake Pichola, located in the city of Udaipur in the Indian state of Rajasthan, is a man-made freshwater lake created in 1362. It was named after the nearby village of Picholi. It is one of several connected lakes that have developed over the last few centuries in and around the renowned city of Udaipur.

Jagdish temple:- Located in the heart of Udaipur in Rajasthan, the Jagdish Temple is a significant Hindu temple situated just outside the royal palace. It has been continuously worshipped
