DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1 - Jaipur Railway station/ Airport to Hotel and Jaipur Local Sightseeing

Meet and Greet our executives at your disposal. Transfer to the hotel and check in to your room. Start your Jaipur Local Sightseeing. We will cover.

Amber fort: The palace served as the home of the Rajput Maharajas and their families. As you enter the palace near the Ganesh Gate of the fort, you will find a temple devoted to Shila Devi, a Goddess of the Chaitanya cult. Raja Man Singh received the temple as a gift after his victory over the Raja of Jessore, Bengal in 1604.

Maota Lake: Maota Lake is situated in the Amber region of the Rajasthan state in India. Its original name is "Mahavata", but it is generally referred to as Maota because of the large trees that grow near the lake.

Nahargarh fort: Nahargarh Fort is a historic fort located on the edge of the Aravalli Hills, providing a panoramic view of the city of Jaipur in Rajasthan, India. It was built in the 18th century and, along with Amer Fort and Jaigarh Fort, formed a strong defence

Day 2 - Jaipur Local Sightseeing

After breakfast, start your Jaipur Local Sightseeing.

City Palace: Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II founded the City Palace, Jaipur in 1727, at the same time as the city of Jaipur, after shifting his court from Amber.

Jantar Mantar: The Jantar Mantar, located in Jaipur, is a site for astronomical observations that was constructed in the early 1700s. It comprises a collection of approximately 20 primary fixed instruments. While many of these are known devices, their monumental construction in masonry often incorporates unique features.

Hawa Mahal: Maharaja Sawai Pratap Singh, the grandson of the founder of Jaipur, Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh, was so impressed by the distinctive architecture of Khetri Mahal that he commissioned the construction of the grand and historic Hawa Mahal in 1799. The palace was designed by Lal Chand Ustad.

Albert Hall Museum: The Government Central Museum, also known as the Albert Hall Museum, is located in Jaipur

Day 3**Day 3 - Transfer to Jodhpur via Ajmer & Pushkar**

After breakfast, you will check out from the hotel and proceed to Jodhpur. En route, you will visit Ajmer and Pushkar. You will start with local sightseeing in Ajmer, which will include the following:

Ajmer-e-sharif Dargah: According to legend, Khawaja Moinuddin Chisti, who hailed from Persia, arrived in India to devote his life to serving and assisting the needy and disadvantaged. The Dargah, which is the shrine of Khawaja Moinuddin Chisti, is said to have been constructed by the Mughal emperor Humayun as his final resting place.

Adhai-Din-ka Jhonpara: The term "Adhai Din Ka Jhonpra" literally translates to "shed of two-and-a-half days" and it is also known as Arhai Din ka Jhompra or Dhai Din ki Masjid. One story suggests that a portion of the mosque was built within two-and-a-half days (as explained in the section below on its conversion into a mosque), while some Sufis claim that the name represents the transience of human life.

Day 4**Day 4 - Transfer to Udaipur & Jodhpur Local Sightseeing**

Embark on your Jodhpur Local Sightseeing after breakfast and check out from the hotel. Our itinerary for the day includes the following destinations. Later, proceed towards Udaipur.

Mehrangarh fort: The fortress, known as Mehrangarh, was given its name which means 'fort of the sun' as it is believed to be a tribute to the clan's fabled lineage from Surya, the Hindu sun god. The wall of the fort is more than 500 yards long, rising up to a height of 120 feet in some sections, and is 70 feet thick. While these fortifications were necessary for the successors of Rao Jodha, they were not always sufficient.

Jaswant Thada: The Jaswant Thada is a memorial structure situated in Jodhpur, Rajasthan, India, built by Maharaja Sardar Singh of Jodhpur State in 1899 to honour his father, Maharaja Jaswant Singh II. The cenotaph serves as the cremation ground for the royal Rajput family of Marwar.

Umaid Bhawan: The Umaid Bhawan Palace in Jodhpur, Rajasthan, Indi

Day 5**Day 5 - Udaipur Local Sightseeing & Drop at Udaipur Airport / Railway station**

Following breakfast, proceed to check out from the hotel and begin your local sightseeing tour of Udaipur. Our itinerary will include the following popular attractions:

City Palace: The City Palace in Udaipur took almost 400 years to construct and was built with contributions from multiple rulers of the Mewar dynasty. The construction was started by Maharana Udai Singh II of the Sisodia Rajput family in 1553, as he relocated his capital from the previous city of Chittor to the newly founded city of Udaipur.

Pichala Lake: Pichola lake is an artificial freshwater lake located in the city of Udaipur, Rajasthan, India. It was created in 1362 and is named after the nearby Picholi village. Over the last few centuries, several contiguous lakes have been developed in and around the famous Udaipur city.

Jagdish temple: The Jagdish Temple, located in the heart of Udaipur, Rajasthan, is a significant Hindu temple situated just outside the royal palace. The
