## DETAILED ITINERARY

### Day 1 - Jaipur Railway station/ Airport to Hotel and Jaipur Local Sightseeing

Upon arrival, you will be greeted by our staff who will be at your disposal throughout your trip. They will transfer you to your hotel and help you check in to your room. You will then start your local sightseeing in Jaipur, visiting various places of interest.

**Amber fort:-** The palace used to be the home of the Rajput Maharajas and their families. Near the Ganesh Gate of the palace's fort, there is a temple devoted to Shila Devi, a Goddess of the Chaitanya religion. The temple was awarded to Raja Man Singh when he defeated the Raja of Jessore, Bengal in 1604.

**Maota Lake:-** Maota Lake is situated in the Amber town of the Indian state of Rajasthan. It was originally named "Mahavata," but it is now commonly known as Maota because of the massive trees that grow near the lake.

**Nahargarh fort:-** Nahargarh Fort is situated on the outskirts of Jaipur city in the Indian state of Rajasthan. It is perched on the edge of the Aravalli Hills and offers a pano

### Day 2 - Jaipur Local Sightseeing

After breakfast, start your Jaipur Local Sightseeing, which will cover following

**City Palace:-** Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, who founded Jaipur in 1727, also established the City Palace at the same time. Before this, his court was located in Amber.

**Jantar Mantar:-** Built in the early 18th century, the Jantar Mantar in Jaipur is an astronomical observation site that consists of about 20 primary fixed instruments. These instruments are huge examples made of masonry and are based on known instruments. However, they also have unique features in many cases.

**Hawa Mahal:-** Maharaja Sawai Pratap Singh, the grandson of Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh, who founded Jaipur, India, constructed the structure in 1799. The palace was inspired by the distinctive design of Khetri Mahal, and Maharaja Sawai Pratap Singh built it as a grand and historically significant building. The palace was designed by Lal Chand Ustad.

### Day 3 - Transfer to Jodhpur via Ajmer & Pushkar

After breakfast, you will check out from the hotel and travel to Jodhpur. During the journey, you will also visit the cities of Ajmer and Pushkar. Once you reach Ajmer, you will begin your local sightseeing tour, which will include the following attractions:

**Ajmer-e-sharif Dargah:-** According to legend, Khawaja Moinuddin Chisti, who hailed from Persia, dedicated his life to helping and supporting the poor and underprivileged people in India. The Dargah Sharif in Ajmer is the revered saint's final resting place, and it is believed that the Mughal emperor Humayun built the dargah

**Adhai-Din-ka Jhonpara:-** Adhai Din Ka Jhonpra means "shed of two-and-a-half days". The mosque was previously known as a "Masjid" and it was the only mosque in Ajmer for centuries. Later on, it became known as a jhonpra when fakirs started gathering here to celebrate the death anniversary of their leader Panjaba Shah. The gathering lasted for two-and-a-half days, which

### Day 4 - Transfer to Jaisalmer City & Jodhpur Local Sightseeing

After having breakfast at the hotel, you will check out and proceed towards Jaisalmer City. Once you arrive, you will start your local sightseeing in Jodhpur where you will get to visit and explore various attractions. Some of the places that you will be covering during your sightseeing tour include...

**Mehrangarh fort:-** The fort was given the name Mehrangarh, which means 'fort of the sun' and is believed to symbolise the clan's legendary lineage from the sun god Surya. With a length of over 500 yards, the walls of the fort can reach up to 120 feet in height and are 70 feet thick in some areas. The successors of Rao Jodha considered these fortifications necessary for the protection of the city, but at times they were not enough to provide sufficient security.

**Jaswant Thada:-** The Jaswant Thada is a memorial structure situated in Jodhpur, a city in the Indian state of Rajasthan. Constructed by Maharaja Sardar Singh of Jodhpur State in 1899, the struct

### Day 5 - Transfer to Jaisalmer Desert & Jaisalmer City Local Sightseeing

After breakfast, you will check out from your hotel and transfer to the Jaisalmer Desert. You will start your Jaisalmer City Local Sightseeing and visit various attractions. The places you will cover may include the Jaisalmer Fort, Patwon ki Haveli, Nathmal ki Haveli, Salim Singh ki Haveli, Gadisar Lake, and other notable landmarks. You will spend the night in the Jaisalmer Desert.

**Patwan Ki Haveli:-** The Kothari's Patwa Haveli has a rich history dating back to the early eighteenth century when the Patwa brothers struggled to establish their trade and business in Jaisalmer. A priest at the Jain Temple advised them to leave Jaisalmer with the belief that their business would not flourish there. As per legend, the Patwa brothers became highly successful after leaving Jaisalmer and their business grew to span across banking and finance, silver, brocade, and the opium trade.

They even became famous for financing the state deficit. This brought the clan back to

### Day 6 - Transfer to Udaipur Via War Museum, Mini Dubai

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed to Udaipur. En route, visit the War Museum and Mini Dubai. During the tour, you will cover the following attractions.

**War Museum:-** IWM, which stands for Imperial War Museums, was established on March 5, 1917. It was created by a proposal put forth by Sir Alfred Mond MP to the War Cabinet for the establishment of a national war museum. The museum's purpose was to document and record the ongoing events during the Great War.

**Mini Dubai ( Dates Farmhouse ):-** The BluSalz Rural The Date Farm Jaisalmer, situated in Sodākor, features a garden, a shared lounge, and a restaurant. The farm stay also includes a bathroom.

Afterwards, continue driving to Udaipur and check in to your room at the hotel for an overnight stay.

Once you've had breakfast, proceed to check out from the hotel and begin your Udaipur local sightseeing tour, during which we will visit:

**City Palace:-** The magnificent Udaipur City Palace was a collaborative effort of multiple rulers from the Mewar dynasty and was built over almost four centuries. Its construction commenced in 1553, under the reign of Maharana Udai Singh II from the Sisodia Rajput family. He commissioned the palace as he moved his capital from Chittor to the newly established city of Udaipur.

**Pichala Lake:-** Lake Pichola is an artificial freshwater lake that was created in the year 1362 and is situated in the city of Udaipur in the Indian state of Rajasthan. It was named after the nearby village of Picholi and is one of several contiguous lakes that have developed over the last few centuries in and around the famous city of Udaipur.

**Jagdish temple:-** Located in the heart of Udaipur, Rajasthan, Jagdish Temple is a prominent Hindu
